From the CEO-Looking Forward >>

Heart Havens entered 2022 with *Looking Forward* as our theme. To protect the health of our residents and employees, by the end of the first quarter of the year, we offered the COVID vaccine to all staff and residents and some volunteers. Also, the government regulations that guide our work underwent radical transformation leading to policy and process changes and frequent external audits. I proudly share that the Heart Havens' team received outstanding reports from the audits.

Heart Havens internally enhanced our quality assurance and improvement program. We implemented Spring and Fall Workdays where volunteers painted, made minor repairs, cleared yard overgrowth and had the opportunity to meet the home staff and residents. When workforce challenges threatened our provision of services, Heart Havens collaborated with the manager of a legacy gift to increase Direct Service Professional wages. Other noteworthy efforts of 2021:

- Preparation and foundation work for potential acquisition of other companies
- Updated flooring and new roofs on some of the homes
- Received a grant for two new accessible vans






Volunteers >>

Volunteers are a key part of empowerment and community integration at Heart Havens. In 2021 and during the year we had approximately 250 volunteers who enriched the lives of the people we support by sharing fellowship and fun experiences and by helping us maintain our homes.

Heart Havens had a spring and fall work day for each home for upkeep like painting, yard work, and power washing. Volunteers also hosted gift card drives, and collected paper goods for their local homes. They invited residents to cookouts and came by for game nights. Heart Havens is so thankful for our volunteers!

Finances >>

Though Heart Havens is primarily funded by Medicaid, we depend on donations to ensure that the people we support are engaged as full and active members of their communities. This includes groceries for healthy, homemade meals, internet and phone plans, household supplies, vehicle expenses so our residents can participate in their community, recreation activities, home maintenance and repair, and incidental medical costs not covered by other insurance. Expenses increased greater than revenue in 2021 as Heart Havens invested over \$100,000 in Direct Support Professional wages prior to Virginia Medicaid increasing reimbursement rates.



Thank you to each and every donor, volunteer and friend of Heart Havens! While each resident receives Medicaid funding through the Developmental Disability (DD) waiver, this funding only pays for staff support and the most basic operations of the home, not for an engaged and fulfilling life.

Donor support is vital for residents' clothes; food for groceries and dining out; participation in community activities; and medical needs like hearing aids, glasses and dental care.

Donations are also needed for home maintenance and repairs; oversight salaries to maintain licensure compliance; and transportation costs like vehicle maintenance and gas.
