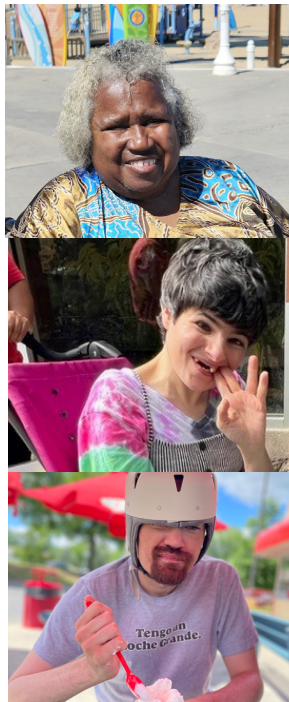


Why Heart Havens Month?
