## Together with volunteers



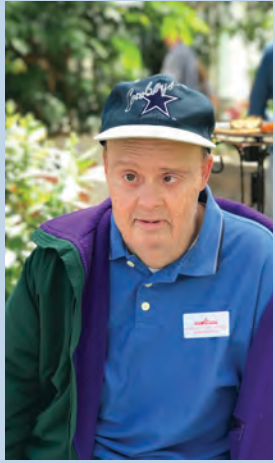

# At home

In 2018, general maintenance and repairs at Heart Havens homes throughout Virginia totaled \$43,585. This number includes repairs that cost less than \$1,000 such as appliance repairs.

When repairs cost more than \$1,000, we classify them as capital expenses. Our 2018 capital expenses totaled \$7,876 and included the following projects:

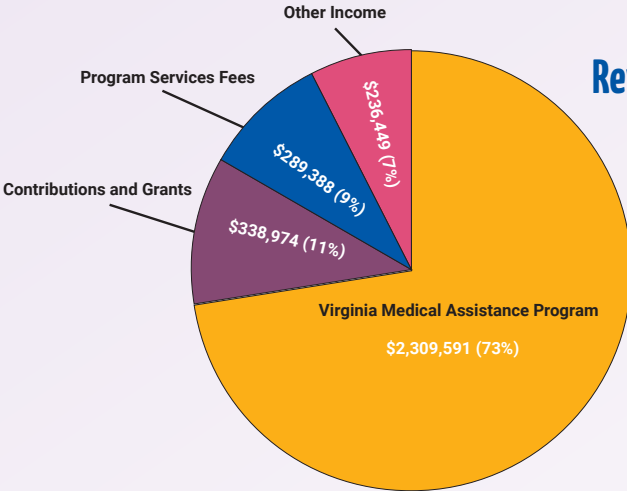
- New laminate floor in bathroom at Macleigh-Holland, \$1,400

- Bathroom updates at Garber Morris, \$4,000



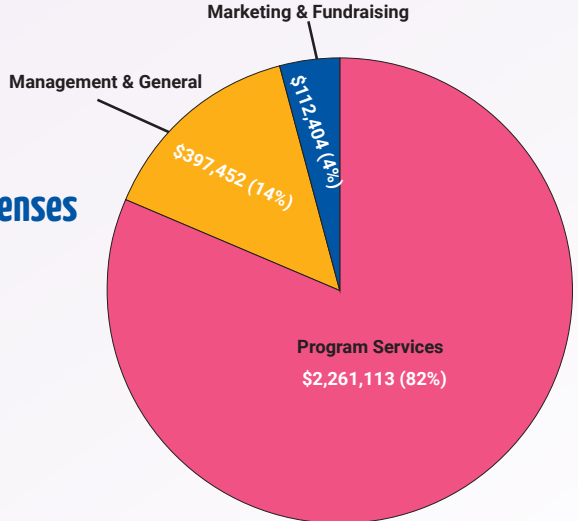
